What is Campus Calgary / Open Minds? How can it benefit you and your students?

Campus Calgary / Open Minds provides Calgary teachers the opportunity to work with a vibrant community site for 5 days of innovative learning. Teachers design and implement a long-term, interdisciplinary study that uses the week with a site as a catalyst for learning. Curriculum expectations can be met through meaningful connections to the real world, hands-on experiences, and connecting with community experts. This heavily subsidized program (actual costs range from \$5000-\$8000/week) is funded by community and business partners, the Calgary Board of Education, and the Calgary Catholic School District. **The cost for the week is \$1500 per week for CBE and CCSD classes, including bussing.** Independent Schools cost is \$1800 per week, including bussing.

How do teachers apply?

Any Calgary teacher can apply. **Application deadline is Wednesday May 6, 2026.** Applications will share who you and your students are and how 5 days with a CC/OM site will influence you and your students' learning and year's work. Selections are *not* made on a first come first serve basis. 3. Campus Calgary / Open Minds is just as much for teachers as it is for students. With that in mind, what do *you* want to come to understand as part of this CC/OM experience?
4. *Why this site?* How do you anticipate this site supporting your big question / idea / provocation and your students' yearlong learning?
5. Tell us about your *students and school community*.

Year at a Glance

General Information Workshops

(February 12 at Teachers' Convention and April 1) Introduction to CC/OM philosophy, application process and requirements, developing a big idea or question or provocation, and site personnel.

Applications due – Wednesday May 6

Acceptance Status – Thursday May 21

Spring In-service - Site Specific

Welcome (after school in June) – initial opportunity for site familiarization, sharing of expectations, and development of working relationships.

Summer Workshop - A Day on Site (July or August) – Immersion at the site and discovery of the rich learning opportunities available at each site

Fall Pedagogy Evening – Journalling

Workshop (after school evening in September) – Immersion in and practicing CC/OM philosophy and journalling.

Practice and Preparation at School

(ongoing)

Planning Meeting (after school at your school or virtual, 6-8 weeks prior to being on site) – In collaboration with CC/OM Operations Team and Site Coordinator, connecting your classroom and your big question to the community, creating a personalized week.

Ongoing Communication in preparation

for site experience – Time between planning meeting and site experience, – feedback on schedule, discussions of roles and responsibilities, etc.

Week on Site – YOUR CC/OM Experience

Back at School – continued connections and engaging in relevant actions

** CC/OM Professional Learning

Workshops – offered throughout the year (both in-person and virtual)

** **Ongoing communication** with site and site coordinator to support learning.

The Campus Calgary/Open Minds (CC/OM) Program is supported through a number of key partnerships between educational districts, community sites, and funders.

- For Calgary Board of Education and Calgary Catholic School District classes, cost is **\$1500**
- For independent, charter and private school classes, cost is **\$1800**
